

GUYING

Three 1.5m x 75mm wooden stakes connected by 7 strand galvanised wire and driven into the ground will effectively pin the rootball. If using an anchoring system with a metal hammer ensure the area is clear of services.

Nowadays rootballs are wrapped with a degradable wire mesh. The guying wires sit directly onto this, wire on wire, which is ideal as it allows the rootball to site as high as possible in the tree pit. Do not use timber battens or extra wire mesh which require the rootball to sit lower in the tree pit.
