



SURFACES

All trees planted in pavements should have a porous surface detail. Soils require a flux to occur at the surface with CO₂ being released and replaced by oxygen. Any surface that is not permeable will impede this process and cause accumulation of CO₂ and anaerobic conditions.

A porous surface will also gain the most benefit from local rainfall. This has a twofold effect as the downward movement of water is a useful vector for the oxygenation of the lower soil horizons. This can be significant for poorly structured sit soils.
